

How to... Print and construct large format eyeleted banners

We have provided the files for three large format eyeleted banners for you to use to spread the word of Universal Infant Free School Meals to both parents and pupils.

They are saved as high resolution jpeg files and should be downloaded and forwarded to your local print supplier.

The finished banners in this artwork are 2000mm (width) x 1000mm (height).

The artwork contains magenta trim and fold lines as outlined below:

The outside line is to be cut along and this will give a size of 2050mm x 1050mm overall.

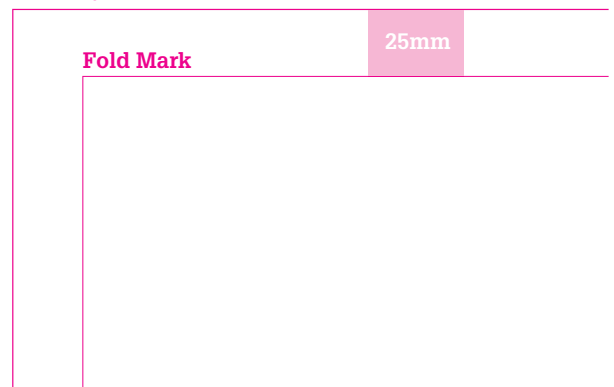
Double sided tape is to be used on the back of the banner to create a hem of 25mm, through which the eyelets are to be punched (*We recommend 25mm brass eyelets*)

To do this the banner must be placed on its front (being careful not to scratch the artwork) and lengths of tape should be run down the edges. These edges should then be folded over so that the inside magenta line is just visible (and therefore hidden when viewing banner from the front).

These banners can then be affixed to walls or fences using cable ties, masonry fixtures or hooks etc.
